Online Application Tutorial

Welcome to MiraCosta's Online application tutorial. We're happy you have expressed an interest in becoming a Spartan and hope that these step-by-step instructions will assist you in completing our FREE online application through CCCApply. Before you begin, you may want to gather some information that may be asked in the application. Not all of these will be applicable to all applicants:

- Social Security Number
- High School Transcript

Depending upon when you graduated from high school, the MiraCosta CCCApply application may ask you to provide the following:

- High school GPA
- Highest high school math/English course completed
- High school math/English coursework and grades
- Have your high school transcript information accessible while applying to help with this step. Students who provide this information on the application will receive an email with their math and English placement within a few days. This placement notification is also available in the Message Center located in your SURF Student Center.
- Permanent Resident Card (aka: Green Card)
- Pen and paper. You will be creating a login and password along with three security questions

Application to College

Before applying to college you must first have an OpenCCC account.

The OpenCCC single sign-in account allows you to access the online services of the California Community Colleges.

OpenCCC is a service of the California Community Colleges Chancellors Office. The information in your account is kept private and secure.

Note: OpenCCC is a new systemwide account. Accounts from our previous application system are not available. Please create an account if you have not already done so.

In order to submit an online application you will first need to create a CCCApply Account. The next 9 slides will take you through how to set up your CCCApply Account. Once you have created the CCCApply Account you can submit applications to any of the California Community Colleges but we're hoping you stick with MiraCosta! If you already have a CCCApply Account go ahead and log in!

You Must Have an Email Address

In order to create your CCCApply account and submit your application you will first need to have an email account set up. MiraCosta will use email as the primary means of communicating with you so it's super important to not only have an email account but to remember to check it regularly for instructions and important announcements.

The California Community Colleges and OpenCCC will use email to send you important information. You will need to provide an email address when you create your account.

Social Security Number

The Social Security Number (SSN) or Taxpayer Identification Number (TIN/iTIN) is used by the college as a means of matching student records, facilitating federal financial aid, and reporting tax-related information to the Internal Revenue System (IRS). However, it is not required for admission.



Providing a social security number or taxpayer identification number is not required with respect to non-U.S. resident students (whether documented or undocumented), students taking noncredit courses, students whose qualified tuition and related expenses are waived or paid with scholarships or paid by an institutional third party including an employer or government agency. (26 C.F.R. § 1.6050S-1.) A SSN or TIN/iTIN is not required when IRS reporting is not required.







MiraCosta College offers a variety of courses. Select the appropriate admission enrollment type. If you are interested in all programs you may choose all three options.

College Credit Courses: College Credit courses are designed to meet requirements for two- and fouryear degrees, certificates, job preparation or advancement, and basic skills and are tuition based.

Continuing Education: Continuing Education courses are tuition-free noncredit courses for adults that are offered in the following areas: Courses for Older Adults, Adults with Disabilities, Citizenship, English as a Second Language, GED Test Preparation, Health and Safety, Parenting, and Short-Term Vocational and Workforce Preparation.

Adult High School: Adult High School courses are tuition-free and can be taken to obtain a high school diploma or to brush up and improve reading, writing, or math skills.
