

Students, employees, or community members wishing to file a discrimination and harassment complaint should work through the campus complaint process described in Administrative Procedure 3435 – Discrimination and Harassment Complaints and Investigations first before escalating issues to any of the following resources.

Issues that are not resolved at the campus level may be presented:

- To the Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges (ACCJC) at <http://www.accjc.org/complaint-process> if the complaint is associated with the institution's compliance with academic program quality and accrediting standards. ACCJC is the agency that accredits the academic programs of the California Community Colleges.
- To the CCC Chancellor's Office by completing a form on the website <https://www.cccco.edu/Complaint-Process-Notice> if the complaint does not concern MiraCosta College's compliance with academic program quality and accrediting standards.
