SECTION V - ELIGIBLE FOR CERTIFICATION

This section is for firms who may be *eligible* for certification as a small/historically underutilized business. Please review the certification definitions provided below before completing this section.

(SBE) Small Business Enterprise

To be considered a "small business" by the State of California, businesses must meet these eligibility requirements:

- Must be independently owned and operated;
- Cannot be dominant in its field of operation;
- Must have its principal office located in California;
- Must have its owners (or officers in the case of a corporation) domiciled in California; and together with its affiliates, be either a
 business with 100 or fewer employees and an average annual gross receipt of \$15 million or less (over the previous three tax
 years), or a manufacturer with 100 or fewer employees.

(SP-PW) Small Business for the purpose of Public Works

For a firm to be eligible for the new SB-PW certification, the applicant firm, including manufacturers, must meet the following requirements:

- Be independently owned and operated;
- Not dominant in the field of operation;
- Principal office located in California;
- Owners, Officers, Members/Managers, Partners must be domiciled in California;
- Average \$36 million or less in gross annual receipts over the last three tax years (including affiliates);
- A business with 200 or fewer employees (including affiliates)

(DVBE) Disabled Veteran-Owned Business Enterprise

For DVBE certification purposes, a "disabled veteran" is:

- A veteran of the U.S. military, naval, or air service;
- The veteran must have a service-connected disability of at least 10 percent or more; and
- The veteran must reside in California.

To be certified as a DVBE, your firm must meet the following requirements:

- Your business must be at least 51 percent owned by one or more disabled veterans;
- Your daily business operations must be managed and controlled by one or more disabled veterans

(DBE) Disadvantaged Business Enterprise

For DBE certification purposes:

- The firm must be at least 51% owned by one or more socially and economically disadvantaged individuals.
- The firm must be an independent business, and one or more of the socially and economically disadvantaged owners must control its management and daily operations.
- Only existing for-profit "Small Business Concerns," identified by the Small Business Act and Small Business Administration
 (SBA), may be certified. DBE applicants are first subject to the SBA's applicable small business size standards. Second, the
 firm's average gross receipts (including its affiliates) over the previous three fiscal years must not exceed the U.S. Department
 of Transportation (DOT) cap of \$20.41 million.
- Each socially and economically disadvantaged owner's Personal Net Worth (PNW) must not exceed \$1.32 million, excluding
 the individual's interest in the applicant firm and the equity in their primary residence.

Socially and economically disadvantaged individual means any individual who is a citizen or lawfully admitted permanent resident of the United States and who is a member of the following group(s): African American, Hispanic American, Native American, Asian-Pacific American, Women, Subcontinent Asian American, or any individual found to be social and economically disadvantaged on a case-by-case basis by certifying agency under the standards of the U.S. DOT 49 CFR Part 26.

(MBE) Minority Business Enterprise

"Minority-owned business" means (1) a business enterprise (a) that is at least 51% owned by a minority individual or group(s) or (b) if a publicly owned business, at least 51% of the stock of which is owned by one or more minority groups, and (2) whose management and daily business operations are controlled by one or more of those individuals. The contracting utility shall presume that minority includes, but is not limited to, African Americans, Hispanic Americans, Native Americans, Asian Pacific Americans, and other groups.

(WBE) Women Business Enterprise

A for-profit business concern whose daily management is controlled by one or more women individuals, **and** the business is at least 51 percent owned by one or more individuals who are women. In the case of a corporation, 51 percent of the stock must be owned by one or more such individuals.
