## HOW TO APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID

### FREE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL STUDENT AID (FAFSA)

- Complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) available at [studentaid.gov](http://studentaid.gov). Use Federal School Code 001239 for MiraCosta College.

### California Dream Act Application (CADAA)

- Undocumented students may be eligible to apply for state financial aid by completing a California Dream Act Application (CADAA) online at [dream.csac.ca.gov](http://dream.csac.ca.gov).

## WHEN TO APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID

### Federal Aid

Students must complete a FAFSA every year. The first day to file a FAFSA for the upcoming school year is October 1.

### California State Aid

Undocumented students must complete a CADAA every year. The first day to file a CADAA for the upcoming school year is October 1.

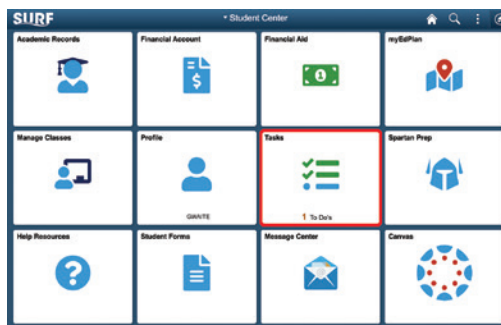
Students should complete a FAFSA or CADAA and submit Grade Point Average (GPA) Verification to the California Student Aid Commission prior to March 2 each year to meet the Cal Grant deadline.

- We will post your financial aid awards on SURF. Initial awards are based on full-time enrollment and will be adjusted after the full-semester add/drop deadline. Eligibility may change throughout the year.
