We've reviewed your financial aid application and are pleased to make the following financial aid offer for the upcoming academic year.

★ These amounts are based on full-time enrollment (12 units or more) and will be reduced for enrollment in less than 12 units as of the full-semester add/drop deadline. Awards may also change based on further review of your application and required documents. If your eligibility changes, you will receive a revised offer.

Fee waivers pay your tuition and fees. This is money goes to the school to pay for classes.

Grants are **FREE** money that you do not need to be pay back. Students can get their \$\$ via direct deposit.
