	<p>Questions 12, 13, 14, and 15: The college revisited the institution-set standards and decided to apply a common criteria across all metrics. Specifically, each standard is now set at 90% of the 3-year average for each metric.</p> <p>Question 14: The number of certificates submitted for 2015 reflects a practice of the college before the 2017 annual report to report a certificate count that included CSU and IGETC certificates. Upon receiving clarification from the ACCJC in spring 2016, the college began reporting a lower amount that did not include those types of certificates and adjusted the institution-set standard accordingly.</p> <p>Question 17: In prior years, for this question, the college reported the number of programs that were tracked through gainful employment (107). However, the number of programs for which a standard for graduate employment rates has been established and reported in question 19 has always been four (4) so question #17 on this particular report was adjusted to reflect that amount for the last three reporting years (2015, 2016, 2017).</p>
