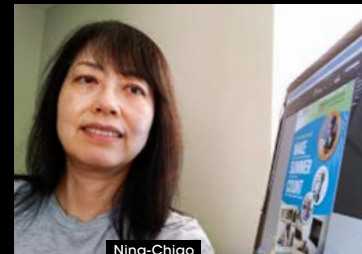

REFUND AND TRANSFER POLICY

Check refunds may take 4–6 weeks to process.

Class/Workshop Refund Policy: Refunds will be made up to three business days prior to the class start date. No refunds will be given once a class has started. A \$15 cancellation fee will be retained for each refund. A full refund will be given if a class is cancelled due to low enrollment. Unused attendance is not transferable to another class session.

Excursion Refund Policy: Refunds will be made up to five business days before the excursion only if the excursion is full and someone on the waiting list is available to take your place. There will be a \$25 cancellation fee if a replacement can be found.

Workforce Training Refund Policy: Refunds will be made up to five business days, depending on course, prior to the class start date. A \$25 cancellation fee for work skills programs will be retained for each refund. A full refund will be given if a class is cancelled due to low enrollment. Unused attendance is not transferable to another class session.

Class/Workshop Transfer Policy: Transfers will be approved up to three business days prior to the class start date. Students must receive a verbal approval from Community Education before a transfer can be made.
