### WHAT IS FINANCIAL AID?

### **Anna L. Cardwell Endowed Scholarship**

This scholarship is for a Reentry MiraCosta College students (25 years or older), with a 3.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidate must be a single parent, planning to continue at MiraCosta College, and enroll in six units or more.

### **Arnold Rice Memorial Scholarship**

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more, and are involved with the Umoja\* program. Umoja: Kiswahili word meaning Unity. The Umoja Program is open to all students, specifically designed to address retention, persistence, success of African ancestry students. Goal is to provide students with resources and tools to assist them in achieving their academic objectives.

### **ASG-ICC Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Scholarship**

The Associated Student Government (ASG) and the Inter-Club Council (ICC) created this merit-based scholarship to serve our disproportionately impacted student population as informed by the college's student equity plan data. This is a merit based scholarship that considers lived experiences, extracurriculars (club involvement and leadership), disproportionate impact, experience as a historically underserved student, and course load etc. Applicants must be currently enrolled students at MiraCosta College (Oceanside Campus, San Elijo Campus, Community Learning Center). A personal statement is required.

### ASG/ ICC Black and African-American Scholarship

The Associated Student Government (ASG) and the Inter-Club Council (ICC) created this scholarship as an equitable opportunity for MiraCosta College students, particularly those who identify as Black or African American, as a means to provide opportunity for individuals who represent these identities. This is a merit based scholarship that considers lived experiences, advocacy within the Black/African American community, extracurricular (club involvement and leadership), disproportionate impact, experience as a historically underserved student, and course load etc. Applicants must be currently enrolled students at MiraCosta College (Oceanside Campus, San Elijo Campus, Community Learning Center). A personal statement is required.

### <u>Asian Pacific Islander Scholarship</u>

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA or higher who demonstrate financial need. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six or more units, or transferring in the fall to a four-year institution. Students must have completed a minimum of 25 hours of volunteer service in the Pacific Islander community, Service activities must be performed while the student is enrolled at MiraCosta College, and service hours must be documented through the Service Learning and Volunteer Center. Students must provide a current Service Learning/Volunteer timecard and an unofficial MiraCosta College transcript. Priority given to those with financial need.



### **Bobbi Williams Endowed Scholarship**

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA of 2.0 or higher, who qualify for financial aid and have financial need. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more, majoring in Horticulture or completed a Horticulture class.

### **Carlsbad Garden Club Scholarship**

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more, majoring in Horticulture. Student must be continuing at MiraCosta College to be eligible to receive the scholarship.

### **Carlsbad Hi-Noon Rotary Club Foundation Scholarship**

Qualified candidates must be Military active-duty or veterans planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more.

### **Carlsbad Rotary Foundation Scholarship**

This scholarship is for graduating high school students, continuing students, residents of Carlsbad, planning to enroll at MiraCosta College in six units of more. Qualified candidates must be either graduating from a Carlsbad High School with a 2.0 GPA or higher, or a current MiraCosta student and resident of Carlsbad. Students majoring in a Certificate program; such as, Automotive Technology, Licensed Vocational Nursing, Registered Nursing, Surgical Technician, or other certificate programs.

### **Carol & Stuart Smith Scholarship**

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA or higher who demonstrate financial need. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more, majoring in Science, with the goal of transferring to a four-year institution in the future. Priority given to those with financial need.

### Clare & Walter B. Taibleson Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more, majoring in Humanities.



### <u>Clarence M. Jackson, Sr. Memorial Endowed Scholarship</u>

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA or higher who demonstrate financial need. Qualified candidates must be planning to continue at MiraCosta College or transfer to a 4-year institution enrolling in six (6) units or more. Student must be majoring in Business or Entrepreneur studies, have completed the MiraCosta Summer Bridge Program or is currently enrolled in the Umoja program. Preference given to students in the Honors Scholar program and receiving the California College Promise Grant (CCPG).

\*Umoja: Kiswahili word meaning Unity. The Umoja Program is open to all students, specifically designed to address retention, persistence, success of African ancestry students. Goal is to provide students with resources and tools to assist them in achieving their academic objectives.

### Col. Harry D. & Patricia G. L'Heureux (USAF Ret.) Endowed Schl.

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.75 GPA or higher who demonstrate financial need. Qualified candidates must be; planning to continue at MiraCosta College, enroll in six (6) units or more, military active duty or veteran or planning to transfer to a 4-year university.

### **Collin Baker Memorial Music Scholarship**

Active enrollment as music major with a minimum of 2.50 GPA or higher and continuing at MiraCosta College.

### **Daisy White Drummond Endowed Scholarship**

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 3.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue full-time (12 units) at MiraCosta College in a degree or certificate program.

### **Dana Carter Memorial Scholarship**

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 3.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more, majoring in Humanities.

### **David and Linda Quinby Endowed Scholarship**

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must have completed or are currently enrolled in two transfer level STEM\* courses (\*Science, Technology, Engineering, Math). Students must intend to pursue a STEM degree in any STEM field including, but not limited to, Science, Engineering, Math, Physics, Architecture or Nursing. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College, enroll in six units or more, and have financial need.

### **David Fallstrom Future Teacher Award**

This scholarship is for a student who has plans to become an elementary or middle school teacher. Qualified candidates must be students who have a 3.0 GPA or higher, have completed Math105 with a



B or higher and are enrolled in Math106. Candidates can be continuing at MiraCosta or planning to transfer to a 4-year college or University in the Fall.

### <u>David M. Jennings II Memorial Endowed Scholarship</u>

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College; with a 3.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be a Student Ambassador planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll full-time (12 units). Preference given to an out-of-state student.

### <u>Delmer I. McCracken Memorial Endowed Scholarship</u>

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be students planning to enroll in six units or more. Student must be pursuing Horticulture and/or be enrolled in a horticulture class and engaged in community service preferred.

### **Donald Kavalec Endowed Scholarship**

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.5 GPA or higher who demonstrate financial need. Qualified candidates must have successfully completed a Spanish class and enrolled in the next level Spanish class at MiraCosta and are planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more.

### Dr. Frances Montalvo Memorial Merit Endowment Scholarship

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 3.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll full-time (12 units).

### Dr. Michael Giansiracusa Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 3.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll full-time (12 units).

### Dr. Romayne Hertweck Memorial Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 3.0 GPA or higher enrolled in 6 units or more. Qualified candidates must be planning to continue at MiraCosta and studying psychology or child development, a passion of Dr. Hertweck.

### **Edward M. Paterson Scholarship**

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 3.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be a Military Veteran, planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more or transferring to a four-year university. Priority given to wounded veterans with financial need.

### **Elizabeth Reid Memorial Endowed Scholarship**

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 3.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll full-time (12 units) or transferring to a 4-year university full-time.

### **Encuentros Scholarship**

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA or higher who demonstrate financial need. Qualified candidates must be a student within the \*Encuentros program, planning to continue at MiraCosta College, and enroll in six units or more.

\*Encuentros is a program to encourage and support boys of Latino descent in middle school and high school to achieve optimal performance in education and in life.

### **Eva Stjernfeldt and Alec Babiarz Endowed Scholarship**

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more.

### Fallbrook Garden Club Scholarship

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 3.0 GPA or higher. The selection shall be based on character, aptitude and ability to succeed. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more, majoring in Horticulture.

### <u>Francisco and Amelia Rodriguez Si Se Puede Scholarship</u>

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 3.0 GPA or higher who demonstrate financial need. Qualified candidates must be designated as AB 540 (undocumented) students, are involved with student leadership activities on campus and/or public service in the community, and plan to continue at MiraCosta College enrolling in six units or more.

### Fred and Dean Metzger Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more. Student must be pursuing life sciences and/or nutrition, and be enrolled in such a class, have completed a financial aid application, and engaged in community service preferred.

### Fred and Louise Krivoski Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College in six units or more who demonstrate financial need. Qualified candidates may be graduating high school students with a 2.0 GPA or higher or a current student who has completed six units and is in good standing with a 2.0 GPA or higher, or a reentry student (25 years or older) who had a three to five year gap in education.

Based on yearly funding available, this may be renewed up to three years, \$3,000 maximum, to a student who maintains a 2.0 GPA or higher, enrolls in six units or more each semester, and remains in good standing with the college.

### Fred Gardner Barnard Memorial Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more.



### Fred W. Meyer Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 3.5 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be students who are planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more, majoring in Horticulture.

### **Friends of Humanities Endowed Scholarship**

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more, majoring in Humanities with an interest in creative writing.

### **Gaiser Family Endowed Scholarship**

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more, majoring in Business with priority towards Accounting.

### **Gender Sexuality Alliance Scholarship**

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA or higher, who demonstrate financial need. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more, and are a member or friend of the MiraCosta Gender Sexuality Alliance; (GSA), (LGBTQ+ is an acronym that stands for Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Trans, Queer or Questioning.)

### **George and Karen Bullette Scholarship**

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA or higher who demonstrate financial need. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more, financial need first, GPA second. Priority given to those with financial need.

### <u>Geraldine Hill Memorial Endowed Scholarship</u>

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 3.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in nine units or more, with priority to students majoring in Business.

### **Gratis Scholarship**

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College, enroll in six units or more each semester, and participate with Disabled Students Programs and Services (DSPS).

### **Gwynne Hodge Scholarship**

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA or higher who demonstrate financial need. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more, enrolled in Dance class.



### Hank & Kathleen Jolly Memorial Endowment Scholarship

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 3.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll full-time (12 units), or students transferring to a four-year institution in the fall.

### <u>Harold Carpenter Memorial Endowed Scholarship</u>

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more, majoring in Automotive Technology.

### Harry J. Phillips Memorial Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is for a student transferring to a four-year institution in the fall, who has completed six units or more at MiraCosta College with a cumulative 3.0 GPA or higher, and a 3.2 GPA or higher in all social science courses attempted. Qualified candidates must be students transferring to a four-year institution, qualifying in one of the social science disciplines: Anthropology, Economics, Geography, History, or Political Science.

### **Hazel Erickson Teaching Scholarship**

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA or higher who demonstrate financial need. Qualified candidates must be students planning to enroll full-time (12 units) at MiraCosta College, or students transferring to a four-year institution, majoring in Teaching (Liberal Studies).

### Henry J. Meier Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA or higher who demonstrate financial need. Qualified candidates must be majoring in Art major and planning to transfer to a 4-year institution in the fall. Preference is given to a student who entered their art in a school show.

### **Herman Tarver Memorial Scholarship**

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more.

### **Horticulture Opportunity Match Endowment Scholarship**

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA or higher who demonstrate financial need. Qualified students must be planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more, majoring in Horticulture.

### J. Arthur & Pauline Drielsma Reentry Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is for Reentry students (25 years old or more), enrolled with Extended Opportunity Programs and Services (EOPS) at MiraCosta College, with a 2.5 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College as an EOPS student, and enroll full-time (12 units).

### James G. Dionisopoulos Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 3.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more, majoring in Art. Preference is given to students who entered their artwork in a student art show while attending MiraCosta.

### James G. Dionisopoulos Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 3.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more, majoring in Art. Preference given to students who entered their art work in a student art show while attending MiraCosta.

### Japanese Club Scholarship

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 3.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more; first priority to students majoring or minoring in Japanese, second priority to students majoring in any language.

### Jean McKee Mowrer Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is for a student at MiraCosta College with a 3.0 GPA or higher who demonstrate financial need. Students must have graduated from a San Diego County high school, plan to transfer in the fall to a 4-year institution, majoring in Teaching, elementary education preferred. Reentry students (25 years of age or older) preferred. The scholarship award will be sent to the 4-year institution after proof of enrollment is received.

### Jean Tweedie Nursing Scholarship

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more, majoring in Nursing.

### 'Jim' Gonzales Emerging Leader Scholarship

Reflecting the genuine care and commitment that Jim Gonzales inspired during his 27 years at MiraCosta College, the recipients for this award share a motivation for empowering themselves and others to embrace and activate their own leadership strengths. This scholarship is awarded to a student who also demonstrates a desire to cultivate change within their community. Applications should demonstrate the nominee's commitment to the following: community, civic engagement, advocacy, and leadership development. A personal statement is required.

### Jim & Nell Reed Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is for students with a 2.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more in an Allied Health major.



### <u>Joe Maak & Pride Resource Partners LLC Scholarship</u>

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA or higher who demonstrate financial need. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College enrolling in six units or more, member or active ally of the LGBTQIA community and/or identify as trans\* and/or gender nonconforming.

Active ally: attend MiraCosta Gender Sexuality Alliance (GSA) club meetings, volunteer on behalf of the LGBTQIA+ community on or off campus, work on behalf of trans\* rights, direct course of study toward promoting equality and equity for the trans\*community, and/or volunteer on behalf of the trans\* community on or off campus, etc.

### John & Aileen MacDonald Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 3.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College, enroll full-time (12 units or more), and have financial need.

### John & Mary Steiger Scholarship

This scholarship is for a student at MiraCosta College with a 3.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be military veterans planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more. Priority is given to an injured veteran with a family, then an injured veteran without a family, then a veteran.

### June Williams Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA or higher who demonstrate financial need. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more.

### K Darren Faller Music Scholarship

This scholarship is for students who have a 2.5 GPA or higher, are music technology major, eligible for continuing students at MiraCosta College and students transferring to a 4-year institution.

### Karen Baum Scholarship

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA or higher who demonstrate financial need. Students must have successfully completed a Sociology class at MiraCosta College. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more.

### **Karetas Family Endowed Scholarship**

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 3.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College, enroll full-time (12 units or more), and have financial need.



### **Kathleen Rippberger Memorial Endowed Scholarship**

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more.

### **Keith Broman Performing Arts Endowed Scholarship**

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in full-time (12 units), or students transferring to a four-year institution, majoring in Music, Art or Theatre.

### **Kendra Keating Scholarship**

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be military active-duty, veteran, spouse or dependent students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more.

### Kenneth and Marie Bertossi Nursing Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA or higher who demonstrate financial need. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more, majoring in Nursing.

### <u>Kiyoko Obayashi Messenger Art Scholarship</u>

Art student who needs extra support for tuition and art supplies. Must exhibit strong academic background and a written desire why they would appreciate getting such support.

### **Knox Williams Endowed Scholarship**

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA or higher, who demonstrate financial need. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more.

### Kuntz-Laughlin Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.5 GPA or higher, who demonstrate financial need. Qualified candidates must be former foster youth planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more.

### <u>La Jolla Garden Club Scholarship</u>

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 3.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be students who are in their second year at MiraCosta College, planning to continue and enroll in six units or more, majoring in Horticulture.



### **LaVerne Schlosser Endowed Scholarship**

This scholarship is for graduating high school students, or current MiraCosta College students with a 2.5 GPA or higher, and plan to enroll full-time (12 units) at MiraCosta College in the fall. Qualified candidates must be students who have graduated from, or are about to graduate from a high school within the San Dieguito Union High School District and plan at MiraCosta College, majoring in Horticulture or Environmental Protection.

\*First priority will be to San Dieguito Academy or Torrey Pines High School, then other schools within the San Dieguito district.

### **Leon Baradat Endowed Memorial Scholarship**

MiraCosta student who has completed 24 or more units at MiraCosta College with a 3.0 GPA or higher. Intent to transfer to a 4 year college or university. Major in Political Science, History, Sociology, Anthropology, or Economics. Demonstrate Financial Need.

### LIFE at MiraCosta College Scholarship

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 2.0 GPA or higher. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll in six units or more.

### <u>Linda A. Koelkebeck Memorial Merit Endowed Scholarship</u>

This scholarship is for students at MiraCosta College with a 3.0 GPA or higher, who demonstrate financial need. Qualified candidates must be students planning to continue at MiraCosta College and enroll full-time.

### **Linda Fogerson Transforming Lives Endowed Scholarship**

### <u>California Dream Act Service Grant Program (DSIG)</u>

The California Dream Act Service Incentive Grant Program encourages California Dream Act Applicants (CADAA) with a Cal Grant B award to perform community or volunteer service. The program awards up to \$3,000 per academic year (up to \$1,500 per semester or up to \$1,000 per quarter) to 2,500 eligible students. The grant will be available to the student for up to 8 semesters or up to 12 quarters while they have an active Cal Grant B award. Eligible students must apply annually and complete community or volunteer service hours in that academic year. Students shall perform at least 150 hours per semester or 100 hours per quarter of community or volunteer service with a qualifying community or volunteer service organization to be eligible for payment.

# Tips for Writing a Great Personal Statement

### Tips for Writing a Great Scholarship Essay

- Be attentive to your audience. As you consider what to write, keep the sponsor in mind and consider these questions:
  - What qualifications are your readers looking for?
  - What sort of person are they hoping to support and why?
  - How will this money benefit you and does that align with the goals of the sponsors?

Often you can focus your writing on an aspect of your life that matters most to those making the award. For example, if a women's organization has a scholarship for single mothers, you might want to write your essay about a challenge you've overcome as a single mom, such as doing your homework before the children get up in the morning.

If you're applying for multiple scholarships, you can often use the same essay. Just be sure to read what each is looking for and modify any specifics as necessary.

- Be focused and specific. Most scholarships ask a very general question, but providing a specific example from your life is much better than just telling the reader about you generally.
  - Use your passion! What interests you will interest your readers as well.
  - Use your words to draw a picture of how this scholarship will matter in your life keeping you in school, buying your books in a timely way, reducing your number of jobs, having reliable transportation, keeping food on the table.
  - Discuss your goals and how you reached this point in your life. Frequent types of examples come from: overcoming a challenge, specifics about how you decided on your career goal, a volunteer or work experience that taught you a life lesson.
- 3. Have others read your essay. Multiple sets of eyes are important not just for proofreading, but for giving you valuable insight into the content of your essay. What makes perfect sense to you might not make sense to someone who doesn't know you. Stop by the Writing Center at either Oceanside or San Elijo HUBs to have a consultant look over your writing for free.

Use the Personal Statement Outline as a *template* to list your ideas when creating your scholarship essay. Think of your Personal Statement like a resume and use it to apply for many scholarships.

Many scholarship awards are based on financial need and/or merit, and your Personal Statement is an important part of the application process. Your essay provides key information the Scholarship Committee needs when nominating a student for an award.

<ol> <li>What are your Education and Career Goals?</li> <li>Write a brief statement outlining your education and career goals; if undecided, state what you hope to gain from the college experience.</li> </ol>
2. <u>Extracurricular Activities</u> List activities you are involved with both on and off campus; for example, clubs, organizations, volunteer service, and sports activities. If applicable, describe your employment experience and how many hours you work per week. Do your activities relate to your education or career objective?
Other Information you would like to share about yourself.
Share information about yourself, tell your story. For example, are you first in family to graduate and attend college, overcome a hardship, military service (deployed, injured), single parent, returning student, international student, etc. State your financial need, and how a scholarship will help you.
