



SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE TO ACCOUNTING STUDENTS!

The San Diego Chapter of the American Society of Women Accountants (ASWA) currently has three scholarship awards available.

Who is eligible?

- Students currently enrolled in an Associate's or Bachelor's Degree program majoring in Accounting, Finance, or Economics in a San Diego County college or university maintaining a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better.
- Scholarships are open to both men and women.

What award amounts are available?

- One \$1,000 scholarship for students enrolled in a Bachelor's Degree program.
- Two \$500 scholarships for students enrolled in an Associate's Degree program.

In addition to the scholarship, all scholarship recipients will receive a free one-year student membership in the San Diego Chapter of ASWA.
