

MiraCosta College Application Instructions for Fall '09 Application

Please walk the students through each question on the application. **Must be done in ink.**

First, ask the students to write **your** name at the top of the application, then turn the application side-ways and write their names.

1. Name – Last, First, Middle Initial.
2. Social Security Number (not required).
3. Male or Female.
4. Date of Birth (month)/(day)/(year)
5. Age **AND** Birthplace; US City or State (Country, if not in US)
6. Dependent of military OR none. If Dependent, just mark Dependent – no need to answer the rest.
7. Citizenship. (If not US citizen, **do not** need numbers, etc.)
8. Telephone with area code.
9. E-mail address – optional.
10. Ethnic Background.
11. Street Address, City, State, Zip.
12. Mailing Address – complete only if different from #10.
13. Major Code – found on last page of application – or 999999 is “undecided.”
14. First box: Currently high school student.
15. Code of High School – found on last page of application (or write name of school).
16. No.
17. If NOT a senior: Second box, “High school student currently enrolled in grades 10-12” (even if in 9th grade).
If a senior: First box, second section, “Received high school diploma” (indicate year).
18. Goal – Any (last is undecided).
19. Former or current foster youth – check box.

20. **B.** All students under 19 years of age must answer 20-29 for **parent or guardian**:
- Choose parent or guardian for whom questions will be answered.
 - Name of parent or guardian (Last, First, MI)
 - Is student dependent of parent/guardian on taxes?

21. Parent/guardian citizenship.

22. Has parent/guardian been in continuous residence in CA for 2 years or more?
▪ If no, last state or country of residence.

23. When did parent/guardian's present stay in CA begin?

24. Does parent/guardian intend to stay living in CA?

25. Within the last two years has parent/guardian:

- Filed state income taxes in another state?
- Voted in another state?
- Petitioned for divorce in another state?
- Attended school in another state as resident of that state?
- Declared residency of another state for tax reasons?

VERY IMPORTANT

24: Try to help students come up with at least two dates – may approximate.

26. Has parent/guardian done any of these?

- Obtained CA driver's license – **how many years**
- Obtained CA vehicle registration, pay fees – **how many years**
- Voted in CA – **how many years**
- Filed CA income tax – **how many years**

If "NO," list any actions parent/guardian that may demonstrate intent to be CA resident (i.e. CA i.d. card, divorce in CA, bank account, loan in CA – and **how many years**).

27. Is parent/guardian an employee of a college?

- CA community college?
- CA state university?
- University of CA?
- Maritime Academy?

If "YES," name – where employed – position

28. No.

29. Parent/guardian employed as seasonal agricultural worker for two months of each of the past two years?

30. Ask students to read and check all three boxes.
