The Downbeat Award-winning Frequency Vocal Jazz Ensemble features student vocalists and instrumentalists from the campus of MiraCosta College in Oceanside, CA. Founded by director Matt Falker in 2006, Frequency regularly travels to festivals and performs at high school, college, and professional performing venues around California and beyond. Each year, they host the Oceanside Jazz Festival and have performed with guest artists including the New York Voices, Take 6, m-pact, Groove For Thought, Gretchen Parlato, and Sara Gazarek.

The ensemble has released a CD entitled "Volume 1: All or Nothing At All". Frequency has been featured as a special guest performer at the Canadian Rocky Mountain Festival in Banff, Alberta, Canada, has toured Costa Rica as a guest of the University of Costa Rica Choral Program, and performed at the invitation-only New York Voices Vocal Jazz Festival in St. Charles, IL. In March 2018, the group competed as one of six college vocal jazz finalists at the Monterey Next Generation Jazz Festival.

The ensemble performs classic and contemporary vocal jazz literature, with an emphasis on vocal creativity and improvisation through both solo and ensemble repertoire. More information about Frequency is available at music.miracosta.edu.
