Registered Nursing Application Checklist

The following documents are needed, if applicable, when applying to the RN Program:

- Current Allied Health Certification
- Relevant work or volunteer experience within the last 3 years (letter from supervisor on Company Letterhead including dates, hours, and duties performed)
- Corpsman experience/medic (DD214 or letter from supervisor)
- Documentation of disability from Student Accessibility Services (SAS) or a physician's note
- Documented copy of eligibility of Financial Aid, Cal Works, California College Promise Grant (CCPG), Federal Pell Grant or EOPS (award letter or SURF award printout accepted)
- Documentation from employer on company letterhead verifying dates of employment or a W2 or a paystub. Dates must correlate with prerequisite coursework.
- Documented copy of eligibility for Extended Opportunity Programs and Services (EOPS)
- Copy of card indicating refugee status
- Military ID card
- TEAS Assessment/readiness test results. All attempts must be submitted officially from ATI to MiraCosta College, and unofficial attempts must be uploaded with the application.
- Written statement confirming first generation to attend college.
- Written statement explaining difficult personal or family situation or circumstance.

Please note all official transcripts and official AP scores must be on file with Admissions and Records two weeks prior to the application deadline.
