### How to Apply: RN

1. Apply to MiraCosta College at <https://www.miracosta.edu/admissions-and-aid/index.html>.
2. When you receive your SURF ID# or Student ID# it is recommended to schedule a general counseling appointment by emailing [onlineadvisor@miracosta.edu](mailto:onlineadvisor@miracosta.edu). Your ID# will begin with a 0 or W. After receiving your SURF ID#, also known as your Student ID number, it is **recommended but not required** to speak with a counselor to ensure that your prior coursework will satisfy our prerequisites and meet the graduation requirements.   - MATH64

  - Any Sociology or Psychology course
