

TIDEPOOLS Entry Guidelines for *Tidepools* 2021

Deadline: Friday, December 4, 2020

Tidepools publishes original art, comics, poetry, fiction and essays exclusively from MiraCosta College students, staff, and faculty, and awards cash prizes to students in each category.

You may submit a **maximum of 3 entries in each of the categories** below. Please observe the following guidelines when submitting your work:

- **Visual Art:** B&W and color drawings, prints, photographs, paintings, mixed media, and graphic design.
- **Poetry:** 1000-word limit, single spaced.
- **Spoken word:** poets must submit a file of a written version of their piece abiding by the poetry guideline above and may choose to include a link to a YouTube video (under 5 minutes) of a performance of that same piece.
- **Fiction:** 1800-word limit, double-spaced.
- **Creative non-fiction and essays:** 1800-word limit, double-spaced.
- **Comic strips and graphic novels/memoirs:** 5-10 panels maximum.

Instructions for All Entries:

- 1) There is no entry fee.
- 2) Do not put your name on your entries.
- 3) Go to www.miracosta.edu/tidepools and click "Submit Now" to fill out a cover sheet for each entry and upload your document file or .jpeg (for art submissions). Cover sheets are available on the Tidepools page at:

- 4) Please do not put in any special symbols in the title of your entry such as #, ?, etc.
