Objective:

To enhance the level of law enforcement service to the public, increase the technical expertise and overall effectiveness of our personnel, provide continued professional development of department personnel, and ensure compliance with POST rules and regulations concerning law enforcement training. The following department policies and procedures will be reviewed:

- 303 – Control Devices and Techniques

Equipment being used:

The MILO System is a use-of-force simulator. The MILO system has several scenarios that the officers must work through. Based on the officers' decisions, the instructors can control the outcome of the scenario. The MILO system is designed to give officers feedback.

Instructors:

The instructors will operate the MILO System.

Officers:

No weapons of any kind (firearms, TASERS, knives, batons, OC Spray, etc.) are allowed during the training. A safety check will happen before every class.

Training:

- Safety Briefing
- Review of department policy
- Legal Updates/ Case Law Review
- Practical training through the MILO simulator
- De-Briefing after scenario(s)
