A. Teleconferencing Meeting Pursuant to AB 361 - *Hull*Description: The Academic Affairs Committee (AAC) will consider whether to authorize teleconferencing meetings pursuant to recent legislation AB 361, since meeting in person would present imminent risks to the health or safety of attendees. In order to continue to meet under these abbreviated teleconferencing procedures, AB 361 requires a legislative body to make specified findings not later than 30 days after the teleconferenced meeting and to make those findings every 30 days thereafter. AAC will consider the circumstances of the state of emergency and determine if the emergency continues to directly impact the ability of members to meet safely in person OR if state and local officials have imposed or recommended measures to promote social distancing.
