RESOLVED, we as the Associated Student Government of MiraCosta College will work diligently with the Equity Department in support of the rights of our LGBTQIA community at MiraCosta College; AND BE IT FURTHER

RESOLVED, we as the Associated Student Government of MiraCosta College will partner with LGBTQIA leaders at MiraCosta College to promote educational events on campus and in the community.
