VI. Updates and discussion on major spring MOE Goals

Members will provide updates on and discuss next steps for committee goals requiring the most significant effort this spring.

- A. **Close current online ed plan and start new 3-year online education plan** in coordination with college education plan development. (Julius)
The Academic Senate and Vice President of Instruction have agreed that as the Education Futures Plan continues to be developed this spring, it is most important to have MOE members represented in the Communities of Practice that will build out the plan around the five identified themes. Development of a new Online Education Plan can happen next year once the Ed Futures Plan is complete.
- B. **Support Distance Education (DE) Certification** workgroup. (Julius/Khan)
Julius and Khan will review the current planned content, development plan, first draft of the first 1-hour module, and feedback received from a Flex workshop.
- C. Revisit institutional practice/guidance around **student participation in Zoom**. (Julius)
Julius will review this action item for MOE and restart committee work on this item.

- F. **Critical eye on Canvas**; advocacy for and building on faculty and student perspectives. (Julius)
Khan will invite discussion on the Discussions checkpoint feature available in Canvas which MiraCosta has not yet enabled.

VIII. Update on DesignPLUS (Julius/Khan)

MiraCosta College acquired a new tool for Canvas, DesignPLUS. This is a user-friendly Canvas plug-in that helps faculty build polished, engaging, and accessible courses. Julius and Khan will provide an overview of the tool and share plans for ongoing faculty support and workshops related to this tool.

IX. AI In Instruction Discussion (Julius)

The Academic Senate will convene a group to develop a starting point for departments to make decisions about the use and non-use of AI in their courses. MOE members are invited to be part of this group, and MOE likely will review a draft to ensure our expertise, especially regarding AI tool selection and guidelines

for usage.
