	Tarman – Maria Lissner presented a new dashboard for feedback. CSLO Assessment Outcomes. The dashboard shows results, can see what percentage of students met and did not meet each outcome. The results can be seen at the course level and can view multiple academic years at once. Committee reviewed the dashboard and made possible recommendations. A suggestion was made to change the colors to make it easier to read. Committee also suggested the data be presented in a different format, if possible.				
	Palmer wanted to know how we can connect whether experiential learning or service learning is being used. Where is data captured for those classes that use services learning for outcomes? Tarman – can possibly be captured in the assessment method in Anthology.				

Palmer - students involved in service learning come out of experiences with amazing outcomes but data is not being captured. Something to think about. Tarman – may be being captured in their management information systems (MIS) data. Benschop suggested contacting the faculty that are using service learning to see if service learning is a component of any assessment they use for their CSLO.					
Myers – West has offered to step in to chair OAC.

"To formulate CSLOs/PSLOs that are smart specific, measurable, achievable, relevant, and future time oriented, OAC recommends utilizing Bloom's Taxonomy. For additional help, please contact the SLO Coordinator." A link will be included for people to access the taxonomies. Pescarmona – one the limitations is around performative SLOs. Those areas were not sure how to scale those outcomes using Bloom's. The group felt constrained in using Bloom's for their outcomes.
