Mandatory Tuition/Fees: Enrollment Fee \$46/unit, Non-resident tuition \$336/unit, bachelor's degree tuition \$84/unit, Health Fee \$19/semester, Student Center Fee \$1 per unit up to \$10 per fiscal year. Enrollment Fee is calculated as 14 units/semester (based on average fall 2018 and spring 2019 school attendance figures) and bachelor's degree tuition is calculated at 12 units/semester.

The Book/Supplies Allowance, Food/Housing, Transportation, and Personal Miscellaneous figures are provided by the California Student Aid Commission (CSAC).
