Facilities Master Plan

The Facilities Master Plan recommends the construction of a new Student Resources Building. In its placement, the CLC is provided with the much needed exterior campus quad and connections to parking. Both the new building and outdoor space will create a college campus that encourages student engagement, enhances the student experience, and improves safety and security on the campus. The addition of square footage will address the identified space deficiencies.

Renovation and modernization of the existing instructional buildings will create flexible and interactive 21st century learning environments and additional student study and tutoring space. These projects will also refresh aging building systems, finishes, furniture and technology.

To address identity and wayfinding issues, the master plan includes a new campus gateway structure at the Mission Avenue entrance. Additional site improvement projects will provide new parking, drop-off, and water-conscious landscaping.
