



## BACKGROUND

The district has utilized Amazon Web Services (AWS) Cloud Computing Services to migrate technology services among district data centers since February 2017. These services assist in ensuring reliable and secure technology and infrastructure as specified in the Technology Master Plan.

## STATUS

Pursuant to Public Contract Code section 10298-10299 and 20653, the district may utilize cooperative purchasing agreements awarded through the California Department of General Services (DGS) Procurement Division California Multiple Award Schedule (CMAS) without competitive bidding.

This purchase will be made utilizing an agreement established by the DGS under the CMAS. This CMAS agreement with InterVision Systems, LLC (Contract #3-18-70-2281L) that provides the lowest cost and best overall value to the District with regard to AWS Cloud Computing Services purchases. With the continual increase in cloud-based technology, it is estimated the cost for services will be in the amount of \$180,000, plus applicable taxes, for the fiscal year period of July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2022.

Funds to renew the cloud computing maintenance and technical support services are budgeted within the district's maintenance budget.

## RECOMMENDATION

Authorize the director of purchasing and material management to proceed with the procurement of \$180,000, plus applicable taxes for the Amazon Web Services (AWS) Cloud Computing Services from InterVision Systems, LLC in accordance with the terms and conditions of the California Multiple Award Schedule (CMAS) (Contract #3-18-70-2281L), as described above.
