The Letters Department seeks to institutionalize programmatic training and assessment practices that had been previously funded by BSSOT and Basic Skills funds. We are asking for three strands of these funds to support our communities of practice among our large pool of associates, all of which prepare them to meet the changing demands on our composition sequence resulting from AB705.

These include: 20K per year for our Highly Supported English (HSE) faculty professional development and programmatic assessment work. Action Plan Objective/Synopsis:

The objective of this plan is to improve rates of student success and retention in ENGL100 and to close the equity gap. This arm of our strategy for addressing the equity gap in ENGL100 addresses programmatic functioning, calling for funds to support faculty professional development, support for communities of practice, and involvement in assessment practices. Over the past two years, Letters was the beneficiary of BSSOT monies and Basic Skills funds which supported our HSE community of practice and professional development (HSE= ENGL100/52) and our assessment of ENGL100 SLOs. As the majority of English courses are taught by associate faculty, these funds proved essential for incentivizing associate involvement and supporting the professional activities that keep our program running. The changes brought about by AB705 and the goals established by the state chancellor's office's Vision for Success require appropriate programmatic work of a department, not just to run assessment and to normalize standards, but where change is essential, to promote pedagogical development and reform.
