How does this align with the college's strategic objectives, program review and/or funding priorities?

Through its work with Veterans and their families, SoCal VBOC promotes the benefits of our Host, MiraCosta Community College. We align with the College's stated values of commitment, integrity, service, inclusiveness and excellence.

Synopsis of grant idea:

SoCal VBOC received a GO-Biz TAP Grant in October 2018 (\$137,500) and is completing its extension period through September 30. For 2020-2021, the VBOC is applying for the Go-Biz TAEP Grant, requesting \$367,895. Grants funds will be spent to increase outreach to veterans and their families in remote parts of our service area through training and counseling. This will require hiring 2 temporary, part-time hourly Business Consultants.

As part of our proposal, the San Diego Procurement Technical Assistant Center (PTAC) will develop and deliver two new workshops – one on Veterans Business Certification and the other on Government Contracting. We will offer these workshops monthly online at the VBOC.

We will also work with Melanie Ray, of Guided Business Plans, to offer her course online, customized for active duty military, Veterans and their families.

Lastly, we plan to work with the newly-launched California Veterans Chamber of Commerce to create/launch the first annual Veterans Small Business Showcase, featuring veteran-owned businesses across the State of California. The inaugural event will be conducted as a virtual event.
