The MiraCosta College Board Room will be a polling site for voting in the California Gubernatorial Primary Election from June 4–7.

The polls are open to the public for early voting and on election day as follows:

- Saturday, June 4, from 8 a.m.–5 p.m.
- Sunday, June 5, from 8 a.m.–5 p.m.
- Monday, June 6, from 8 a.m.–5 p.m.
- Tuesday, June 7, from 7 a.m.–8 p.m.

Governance Survey Results

The college conducted a survey of governance structures and processes during spring 2022, which demonstrated that most employees (80%) understood the governance process and that they felt included and encouraged to participate (79%). Based on the qualitative data of the governance survey, the College Council identified three top priorities for the 2022-2023 academic year to streamline and enhance communication, seek broader participation among associate faculty and classified professionals, and improve education on the governance process. The table below reflects the percentage of respondents who either agreed or strongly agreed with each statement.

I am aware of the current governance structure and its committees.	80%
The committee responsibilities are easy to understand.	69%
I generally know how to use the governance structure to raise an issue or present an idea.	57%
The governance structure addresses issues within a realistic timeframe.	58%
All constituent groups are encouraged to participate in the governance structure.	71%
My constituent group is encouraged to participate in the governance structure.	79%
Decision-making at MiraCosta follows a clear process.	49%
Decisions made within the governance structure are communicated broadly.	61%
Overall, decision-making at MiraCosta values participatory governance.	63%
