Placement

Orientation

Offered four times a week via Zoom videoconferencing. These one hour sessions are currently available in English and Spanish and contain valuable information to help you be successful. Once you sign-up for orientation, you will also be given access to our self-paced online orientation in Canvas. Sign-up for NCESL orientation.

Adult High School (AHS) Onboarding Services

Placement

You can earn credit towards your Adult High School Diploma by providing transcripts of any other school you have attended. As part of the Adult High School Orientation you will also be asked to complete a "Multiple Measures" form which asks about classes you may have already taken at other schools. Our counselors can work with you to decide which classes you need to take based on your school history and your goals. We recommend that you send official copies of your transcripts to our Admissions and Records office (address below) as soon as possible. Orientation
