

The Associated Student Government shall conduct annual elections in accordance with the Associated Student Government constitution to fill the elected officer positions, to be conducted in accordance with the Associated Student Government constitution and under the supervision of the vice president of student services, or designee, who shall certify the election results.

In accordance with the organization's constitution and bylaws, the Associated Student Government may also appoint officers to positions on committees not otherwise determined by election.

Any student elected or appointed as an officer in the Associated Student Government shall meet both of the following requirements:

- A. The student shall be enrolled in the college at the time of application and throughout their term of office, with a minimum of five (5) semester credit units or the equivalent.
- B. The student shall meet and maintain the grade-point average of 2.0 at the time of application and throughout the term of office.
- C. The student shall be free of any academic or disciplinary restrictions from the district.
