What is financial aid?


Financial aid consists of funds provided to students and families to help pay for postsecondary educational expenses.

Types of Financial Aid you may be eligible to receive

- <u>Pell Grant</u>: Does not need to be repaid (based on financial need)
- -<u>California College Promise Grant</u>: tuition fee waiver for the cost of classes (based on financial need)
- -Scholarships! Check out our scholarship website in early spring!

1st Day of summer classes June 10th

Financial Aid will Process first disbursement after the add/drop deadline (late June)

Earliest disbursement of financial aid funds will be deposited via direct deposit/BankMobile <u>early July</u>
